

Technology-Driven Agricultural Marketing Solutions for Sustainable Farming

Additionally, blockchain minimizes post-harvest losses by improving supply chain efficiency. By storing verified data on farm practices and certifications, it strengthens consumer trust. Integrating blockchain in agricultural marketing can revolutionize the sector, ensuring transparency, fair pricing, and sustainability while empowering farmers and consumers alike.



KVK Targhadia also celebrated the event with a total of 30 farmers and farm women. Dr. G. V. Marviya, Senior Scientist and Head of KVK




